Major Accountabilities:

The substitute will provide support and structure to the classroom when the scheduled teacher cannot be present. Hours vary from 8:15 to 3:30 Monday – Friday as needed.

Education:

Bachelor's Degree required and an understanding of the Waldorf pedagogy is preferred.

Experience:

One year minimum of experience working with children ages Pre-K to Grade 8 in a group setting. Substitutes must pass a background check.

- Humor – uses appropriate humor to maintain a positive environment
