Faculty and staff will be reporting to school on Monday, March 16, to finalize a plan to continue delivering our Waldorf curriculum to the students during this shutdown.

Students in attendance today should bring all their belongings home this afternoon. If you are unable to bring your child(ren's) things home today, instructions will be given on Monday detailing when you will be able to pick them up.
