Candidates must be committed to excellence in teaching, parent education and dialogue, self-development, collegial cooperation and the desire to work with the anthroposophical foundations of the curriculum. Bachelor's degree is required (bachelor's degree in education is preferred) as well as a Waldorf Teaching certificate or degree and/or the commitment to achieve one is required.

The Grade 1 teacher must have: excellent verbal and written communication skills; the ability to organize, plan and implement a lesson; the capacity to work with students at many ages and stages of development (Grades Teachers move with the class from Grade 1 to Grade 8) and be able to participate in our active community life.

PHWS was founded in 1987 and is situated on 14 lovely acres of countryside that includes gardens, fields, wetlands and small woods between Milwaukee and Madison, WI. Outdoor play and activities are a vital part of Waldorf education at Prairie Hill.
