After Camp Care: 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm \$30 per week

Week 1: June 7-11 Grow Garden Grow

Enjoy working in the beautiful gardens around Prairie Hill. Our little 'Gardeners' may make bouquets, work with the vegetables, and enjoy tending Mother Nature in all her Summer Glory!

Week 2: June 14-18 Bugs & Butterflies
