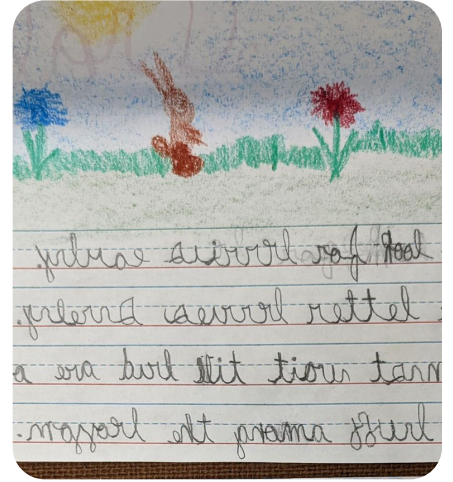


# Spanish Teacher for Grades 1-8 2023-2024 School Year

#### The right candidate will:

- Teach two to three 40-minute periods for each grade, one through eight
- Attend a weekly mentor meeting with the other specialty faculty, usually held during a lunch period

- Write end of the year reports
