

# Full-Time Kindergarten Assistant Immediate Opening



Prairie Hill Waldorf School is taking applications for an immediate full-time Kindergarten Assistant. Our ideal candidate will have a bachelor's degree with prior teaching experience. A Waldorf certificate or degree is preferred. The assistant will work collaboratively within the Early Childhood department and the Lead class teacher. We seek a candidate who is committed to the values of Waldorf education, who is joyful and warm, with strong interpersonal communication skills, effective classroom management, and enthusiasm for teaching and learning.

Duties will include:

- Food prepping and lunch set up
- Naptime set up (in three Kindergarten rooms)
- Clean up from lunch, naptime and activities
- Stepping into each of the three Kindergarten rooms to allow for breaks
- End of day clean up in the three Kindergarten rooms

We have 162 students from pre-k to grade eight, robust parent and tot classes and an outstanding faculty & staff of 30.
